CatClub: Question 20



1. Recap: Last week we learnt that the idea of a 'Redeemer' was a person who 'bought back' something or someone from whoever owned them. In Egypt, God's people were 'bought back' from their slavery to the Egyptians at the cost of the blood of a lamb. This was a picture of what happened on the cross where God's people were 'bought back' from their slavery to sin at the cost of the shed blood of Jesus on the cross.

<u>So (Q20) now asks</u>: Who is the Redeemer? <u>Answer:</u> The only Redeemer is the Lord Jesus Christ, the eternal Son of God, in whom God became man and bore the penalty for sin himself.

2. Investigation:

- (i) Please look up (in the New Testament) <u>John chapter 14, verse 6</u>, then <u>Acts chapter 4, verse 12</u>. In both verses we read that <u>Jesus is the ONLY Redeemer</u> the ONLY person who can save you from your sins.
- (ii) Please look up <u>John chapter 1</u>, <u>verses 1-14</u>. If you replace the phrase 'the Word' with 'Jesus', you'll understand much more about him.
- (iii) Please also look up <u>John chapter 8</u>, <u>verse 58</u>. This is an extraordinary verse. It tells us that <u>Jesus is the eternal Son of God</u>. This means that <u>he has always existed as God's Son</u>, even before he was born.
- (iv) Jesus was both God and man. How do you know he was God (i.e. God the Son)? Give some examples of how Jesus proved this by the things he did this during his life. (Clues: water/wine; illnesses; disabilities; demons; death; fishing; temple tax in fish; hunger; bad weather; where he walked; fig tree.)

How do we know that Jesus was also a <u>man</u>? Please look up <u>John chapter 11, verse</u> <u>35</u>. This is the shortest verse in the Bible: what does it tell you about Jesus?

(v) Please look up (in the Old Testament) <u>Isaiah chapter 53, verse 3-6</u>. Verse 5 mentions '<u>chastisement</u>', which is another word for 'punishment' or 'penalty'. <u>Jesus bore the penalty for human sin himself on the cross</u>.
