## **CatClub: Question 38**



This week we start four sessions on the very important topic of prayer.

1. Recap. Last week learnt how God the Holy Spirit, the third person of the Trinity, helps us: and one of the most important things he helps us with is prayer.

<u>So Q38 now asks</u>: What is prayer? Answer: Prayer is pouring out our hearts to God in adoration (or 'praise'), confession of sin, thanksgiving and supplication (or 'petition').

#### **Explanation:**

- (a) Adoration means <u>lovingly praising God Father, Son and Holy Spirit for who he is.</u>
- (b) Confession of sin means saying sorry to God for all the ways we have broken his Commandments.
- (c) Thanksgiving means thanking God for everything he has done in saving us from our sins and in answering our prayers.
- (d) Supplication means <u>humbly presenting our requests to God, for ourselves, for other people, for events in the world and in particular for the success of the gospel in saving people from their sins.</u>

In order to remember these four elements of prayer, they can be summed up in the word <u>ACTS</u>, which stands for: <u>Adoration (A); Confession of sin (C); Thanksgiving (T); and Supplication (S)</u>.

1. (In the Old Testament): <u>Psalm 62, verse 8</u>. This verse tells us that Christians should trust God at all times and that we should pour out our hearts to him in prayer because he is our refuge – the only One who can really help us in our lives.

# The A-C-T-S of Prayer

## 1. Adoration



4. Supplication

2. Confession

As you come to God the Father in prayer, think of the cross where Jesus died for your sins. Then...

- 1. First, express your adoration for God by lovingly praising him for who he is Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- 2. Second, confess your sins to him, asking for forgiveness for all the ways you have broken his Commandments.
- 3. Third, thank God for everything he has done in saving you by sending his Son to die for you and for answering your prayers and for anything else you want to say thank-you for.
- 4. Fourth, humbly present your requests (supplications) to God, for yourself, for people you know, for events in the world and in particular for the success of the gospel in saving others from their sins, both locally and elsewhere in the world.
